1. CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER:

They got a variance at c 1 zoning and They got a variance for c 2. They would like to do some type of construction on the lot behind them. They will have to come before us and make sure this is correct for the lot. They would like to put up a fence, but they need to come before the planning board to make sure the plan is correct. So, there's a little bit of disconnect between code enforcement and our building and the process.
- Like Ms. Solina did tonight, she did the subdivision. Okay? Thank you for coming in tonight. So, it's like walking him through the process rather than having him haphazardly because sometimes I know that it gets confusing after they got their variants there was still more to be done. And I don't know why they didn't direct them to the planning board, but they didn't. They just went to

code and building, and building said, okay. Sarah is going to work on the form with Jason. Hopefully that will eliminate the confusion because it's happened more than once.

- The dog wash, same thing, where people need to be guided, structured along the way. Okay?
- Planning consultant is in sunny Florida right now, but she's been working behind the scenes. She works when she's down there, and I've been in contact with her.
- Town attorney is not here. He will be here at the next meeting because there's a lot going on.
- Board Liaison: Mr. Pender, what do you have for us? I am just observing and learning as we go along. Thank you, I appreciate it.
- Board Clerk: Margaret Derk is our new Board Clerk, she's doing 1 bang up of a job. We're looking forward to having her go on. So, Margaret, just make sure that this motion tonight is carried through and that it's publicized for the public hearing.
