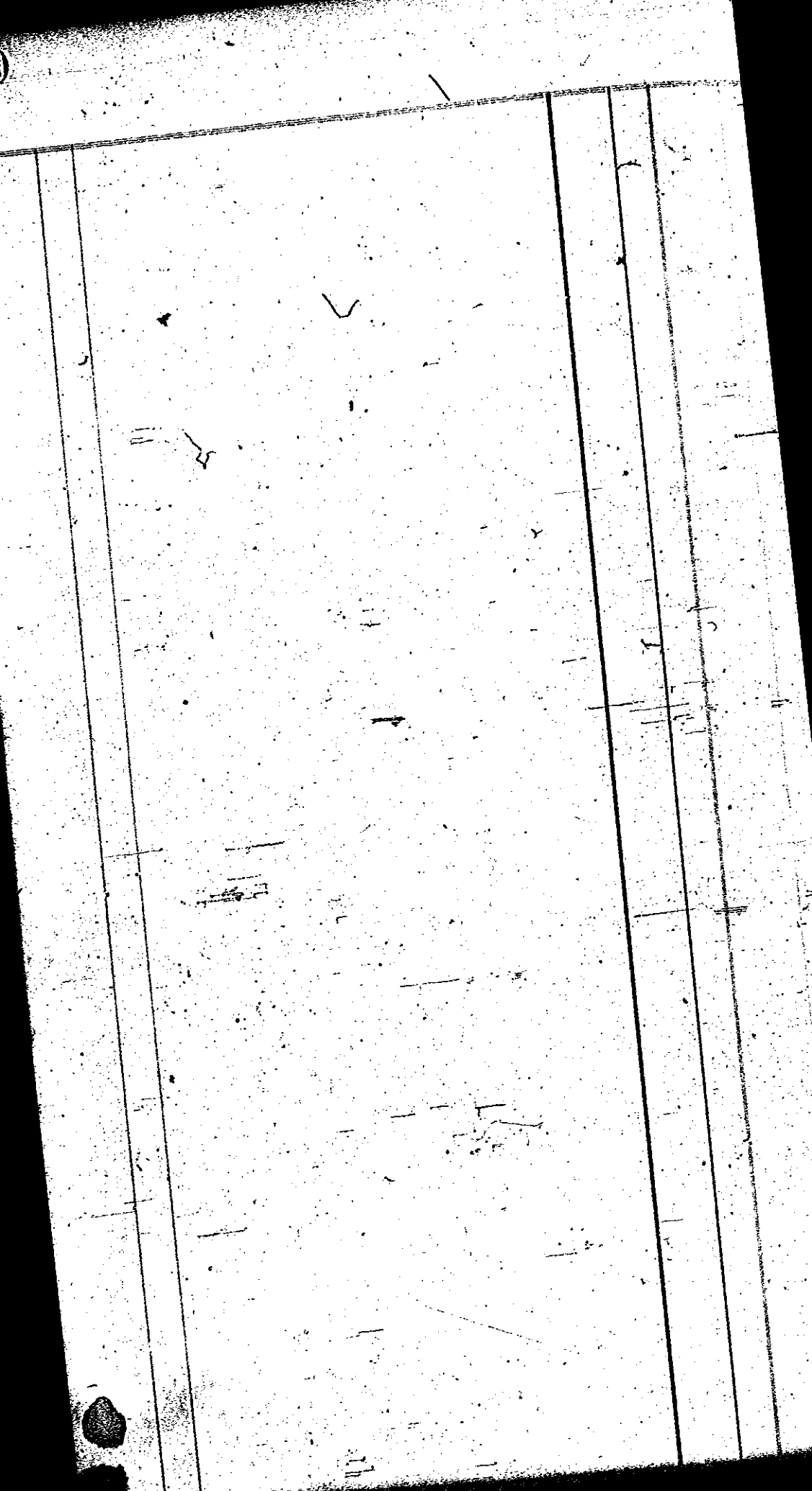

A Boarding Meeting called to Order by Edward Hennrich Supervisor of the Town of Boston

This Agreement Entered this 14th day of February 1910 by and between Fred Kummer Town Superintendent of Patchin N.Y. and the undersigned Members of the Town Board of the Town of Boston County of Erie constituting a Board for the purpose of determining the places where and the manner in which the moneys levied and collected in said Town and received from the State as State Aid shall be expended for the Repair and Improvements of Highways

It is also agreed that we hereby set aside for the general Primary work upon the Highways in said Town an average sum of Twenty Dollars (20.00) per mile for 64 miles which is the total mileage of Highways within the Town of Boston Making a Total 1280.00

Motion made by Chas Endress and seconded by John W. Gasper that we also agreed to set aside Eight Hundred Dollars (800.00) for Repair and construction of sluices culverts and Bridges having a span of Less than five feet

it is also agreed that we set aside the following sums for the Permanent Improvement of Highways Exclusive of sluices culverts and Bridges having a span of less than five feet but including Ties Draining at such Points as may be directed by the County Supt upon the following named Roads

on the Road commencing at Jim Larins Place leading to the foot of Hill up Past the school house a distance of 1/4 mile \$50.00

on the Road commencing at Lonio Wmity Wagon Shop leading to the Iron Bridge a distance of 1/8 mile \$25.00

on the Road commencing at B. & S. Railroad Station at Boston and leading to the State Road at Boston a distance of 1/2 mile \$335.00

on the Road commencing at B. & S. Railroad Station at North Boston leading to the State Road at N. Boston a distance of 1/2 mile \$50.00

on the Road commencing at J. W. Wmeyer Road leading to Edward Hennrichs Place a distance of 1/8 mile \$25.00

it is also agreed that there be Reserved in the Hands of the Supervisor the sum of five Hundred 78 dol. 36
