Update On Recent Market Events

NYCLASS is a local government investment pool serving New York municipal corporations. NYCLASS has issued the following statement in light of the recent developments regarding Silicon Valley Bank and Signature Bank (collectively, the "failed banks") and the resulting market uncertainty.

NYCLASS did not have any direct exposure to any failed banks, nor did NYCLASS have financial relationships with any of the failed banks. In fact, all of NYCLASS' bank exposure is within the FDIC insurance coverage limits and/or fully collateralized. The failed banks generally operated in a different banking sector than traditional banks and, as a result, we believe that, based on credit fundamentals, the risk should not be systemic. The Federal Reserve has created a Bank Term Funding Program to backstop the entirety of the banking system; however, recent market events suggest that investor behavior warrants enhanced due diligence.

NYCLASS' cash deposits are fully collateralized and maintained with a diverse group of financial institutions. Our disciplined investment process continually evaluates the strength and capitalization of our U.S. money center and regional counterparties, and indicates asset quality is strong, net interest margins are robust, and funding is solid in the fixed-income markets.

NYCLASS does not expect the closure of the failed banks to have any impact on our operations. We will continue to monitor the situation and any impact on NYCLASS or our participants.

Pursuant to Section 104a of the Highway Law the following described highway:

Beginning on NY Route 16 from reference marker 16 5302 1129 to reference marker 16 5302 1134 in both the north bound and south bound directions.

Beginning on US Route 20 from reference marker 20 5302 1339 to reference marker 20 5302 1345 in both the east bound and west bound directions.

Beginning on US Route 20A from reference marker 20A 5301 1084 to reference marker 20A 5301 1090 in both the east bound and west bound directions.

Beginning on NY 198 from reference marker 198 5301 1005 to reference marker 198 5301 1011 in both the east bound and west bound directions. Also including Grant Street from Rockwell Road to Military Road in both the north and south bound directions.

Beginning on US Route 62 from reference marker 62 5303 1162 to reference marker 62 5303 1168 in both the east bound and west bound directions.

Beginning on US 219 from reference marker 219 5312 1081 to reference marker 219 5312 1248 in both the north bound and south bound directions.

Beginning on NY Route 179 from reference marker 179 5301 1030 to reference marker 179 5301 1044 in both the east bound and west bound directions.

Also, including Two Rod Road from reference marker 954G 5301 1111 to reference marker 954G 5301 1028 in both the north bound and south bound directions.

All in the Towns of East Aurora, Eden, Hamburg, North Boston, Orchard Park, and Springville, City of Buffalo, and Villages of Depew and Lancaster, Erie County.

Which is being reconstructed under Contract No. D264861 is hereby designated as a Restricted Highway. Designation of Restricted Highway shall expire on October 30, 2024.

Pursuant to Section 1625 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law all movement of vehicles, persons or animals on such highway is hereby restricted and regulated in accordance with the determination of the Commissioner of Transportation as evidenced by posted signs, signals or barriers placed along said highway and/or by direction by an authorized representative of the Commissioner of Transportation.

Any action taken by the Commissioner of Transportation pursuant to Section 1625 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law shall supersede any other provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Law where inconsistent or in conflict with respect to the following enumerated subjects:

- 1. Establishment of maximum and minimum speed limits at which vehicles may proceed along any such restricted highway.
- 2. Weights and dimensions of vehicles.
- 3. Use of such restricted highway by pedestrians, equestrians, and animals.
- 4. Parking, standing, stopping and backing of vehicles.
- 5. Control of persons and equipment engaged in work on such highway.

The provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Law with respect to registration shall not apply to vehicles and equipment engaged in work on such restricted highways.

When used on such restricted highways, all traffic control devices shall be considered as official traffic control devices and shall conform to the manual and specifications for a uniform system of traffic control devices adopted by the Department of Transportation.

Title 17 NYCRR Part 155

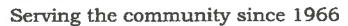
Traffic Regulations on Restricted Highways (Statutory authority: Vehicle and Traffic Law, Section 1625.)

- **Section 155.1 Definition.** The term *restricted highway* when used in this part shall mean any highway or portion thereof under construction or reconstruction under the supervision of the Commissioner of Transportation and which is designated by the Commissioner as a restricted highway pursuant to Section 104a of the Highway Law.
- **155.2 Traffic control devices.** Unless otherwise posted, traffic control devices used on restricted highways shall conform to the requirements of the Vehicle and Traffic Law.
- **155.3 Flagmen.** Operators of vehicles on restricted highways shall follow the directions of any flagman with respect to movement of such vehicles.
- 155.4 Control of persons and equipment. Construction personnel and equipment engaged in work on such restricted highway shall be afforded the widest latitude in operating within the restricted highway consistent with the safety of the traveling public. This shall include, but not be limited to, the crossing of the highway and the mall; the shutting-off of lanes of travel consistent with the contract and the orders of the Commissioner of Transportation or his duly authorized agent; the loading, unloading and manipulation of material; the movement and direction of vehicles and equipment; and other similar operations necessary to the reasonable and practical performance of the contract.
- 155.5 Other requirements. The other provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Law relating to motor vehicles shall not apply to special purpose construction equipment, such as described in section 401, subdivision 7, paragraph (f) of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, while engaged in work on a restricted highway, except that all such vehicles and equipment shall be kept in safe, mechanical operating condition at all times and reasonable caution shall be used to protect the traveling public. However, such other provisions shall apply to those vehicles that normally operate on public highways to transport persons and/or material and are ordinarily considered commercial vehicles.
- 155.6 Emergency or unusual conditions. The Commissioner of Transportation may, by the erection of signs, signals or other traffic control devices, alter or modify the provisions of this Part to adequately protect the public at locations where emergency or unusual conditions occur or exist as a result of the construction or reconstruction on a restricted highway. These alterations or modifications shall have the same force and effect as though they were specifically set forth in this Part and shall remain in force until the condition is considered by the Commissioner to be safe and the erected signs, signals or other traffic control devices have been officially removed.
- 155.7 Effective date. The provisions of this Part shall be effective with respect to a specific restricted highway from the date the highway is designated a restricted highway by an official designation of the Commissioner of Transportation. The provisions of this Part shall also be effective with respect to all restricted highways which have theretofore been designated as restricted highways by the Commissioner of Transportation and on which the restriction has not been removed by a notice of cancellation issued by the Commissioner of Transportation.
- **155.8 Restricted highway designations.** The following locations are hereby designated as restricted highways, as defined by Section 155.1 of this Part.

Dear Boston Town Board Members,

The Boston Emergency Squad, Inc. has operated as an all-volunteer community-based ambulance service for the Town of Boston since its inception in 1966. The Squad was started by a group of concerned residents recognizing the need for organized EMS coverage lacking with the existing fire protection within Boston. It has evolved from a first aid transport unit to an advanced life support level operating two ambulances, answering 700 calls in 2022. As 1 of 4 emergency service organizations in the town, and the only one covering the entire town, BES is focused on keeping ambulance service possible. Our operation is at a critical crossroad of dealing with costs and funding, along with a declining and aging roster. Minimal costs to continue service are exceeding our budget and extras have come exclusively from grants and donations rather than town tax money.

BES is the only stand-alone EMS agency in the area that is not billing for services. Last year New York State passed the EMS Cost Recovery Act allowing fire companies, that run an ambulance, to bill for their EMS calls. With the passage of this law, billing insurance companies for EMS services is becoming the norm. BES has researched 3rd party billing over the past year and see it as a means to address double-digit rising costs for equipment and services to maintain our community-based advanced life transport certification.

This being stated the Boston Emergency Squad wishes to inform the town that the Squad intends to begin 3rd party billing as allowed by the NYS legislation EMS Cost Recovery Act. It is understood that this will affect the citizens of the town and it is requested that the town board, understanding the varied opinions on any change to town services, assist the squad in relaying this change to the town population in some manner. The Squad's goal is to preserve community-based ambulance services for which it is contracted to provide. BES will prepare any background information (PowerPoint presentation) necessary to provide the facts and reasonings for the move to 3rd party billing, that will assist in answering concerns.
