On 1/8/2016, Jennifer A. Mule filed a verified complaint with the New York State Division of Human Rights ("Division") charging the above-named Respondents with unlawful discriminatory practices relating to employment in violation of N.Y. Exec. Law, art. 15 ("Human Rights Law").

After investigation, the Division found that there was probable cause to believe that the Respondents had engaged in unlawful discrimination.

The parties have entered into a private settlement of the matter, and Complainant's counsel has submitted a written statement requesting that the complaint be discontinued.

On the basis of the foregoing and pursuant to the Rules of Practice of the Division, I hereby consent to the discontinuance of the proceeding with prejudice.
