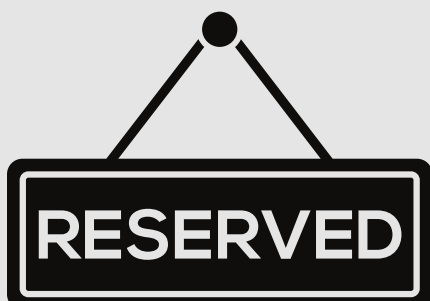




ERIE COUNTY HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) CONTACTLESS COLLECTION EVENT

Making your safety a priority

1 MAKE AN APPOINTMENT



Go to www.erie.gov/recycling and choose an appointment time slot to drop off your household hazardous waste (HHW) at the collection event. Or call the HHW Hotline Number (716-858-6800) and a representative will help you choose your appointment time.

2 GET IT TOGETHER



Find old and unwanted pesticides, herbicides, fertilizer, pool chemicals, solvents, stains, resins, adhesives, automotive fluids, drain cleaners, oil based paint, and spray paint in your house, shed and garage. Please don't bring cans of latex/water based paint.

3 PLACE IN TRUNK



On the day of the collection event, place all the containers of materials in your trunk, rear of SUV/van or pickup bed. Do not place materials in your seating area. No more than six boxes of items and four 5-gallon pails will be accepted. We are unable to return emptied containers to you.

4 BE ON TIME & BE PATIENT



Please arrive as close as possible to your appointment time. Your check in number will be your license plate. We have timed the number of cars we can handle each 15 minute interval. We appreciate your patience with our new procedures.

5 BRING A MASK & STAY IN VEHICLE



Staff, volunteers, and contractors, will all be wearing masks for your and our safety. There is no paperwork required at the event. We request that you stay in your vehicle with the windows closed and also wear a mask when the containers are being removed from your vehicle.

6 WE'LL USE SIGNS, HAND SIGNALS OR CALLS TO COMMUNICATE



We are so glad you are here. To keep us all safe we will use signs and hand signals to communicate with you. If you have a question you can call our on-site cell phone to talk.
